When looking at the report card details data you will see results from 2014-15 and 2015-16. This is a result of an intact group of students that attended Clover Ridge and were tested as 3rd Graders at Timber Ridge, which accounts for approximately 55% of our student body that continued to Timber Ridge. A significant number of Clover Ridge students are showing considerable growth from one year to the next and are provided needed additional support in order to meet grade level standards.

This past year all students accessed interventions and/or enrichment in reading and math, a model that will continue this

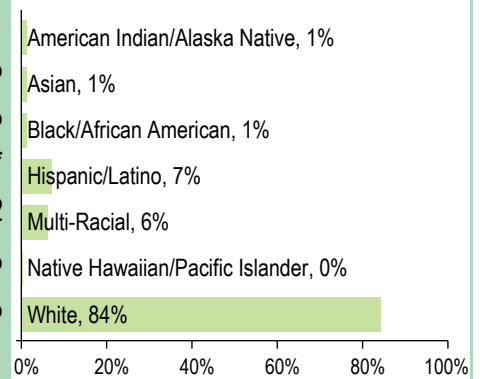

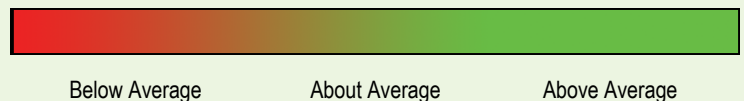
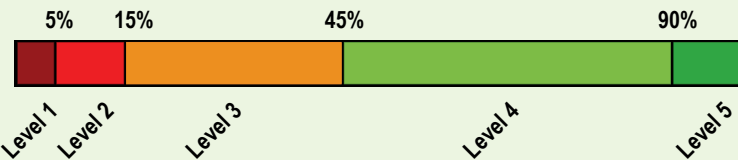
